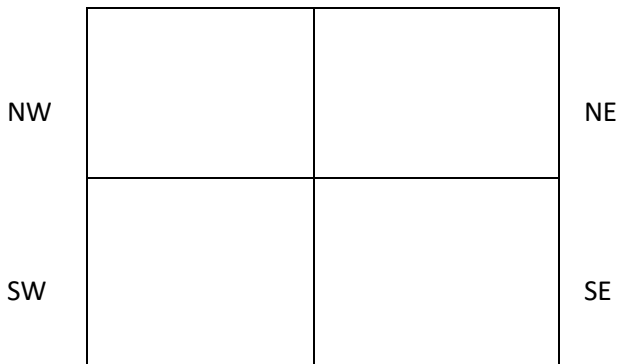

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TERMS AND CONDITIONS

General Terms & Conditions:

- The annual projects resulting from this program will be subject to funds appropriate
- Failure to comply to any of the said terms and conditions may negate the landowner's eligibility to participate in further SRWD programs.

Landowner Responsibility:

- Complete and sign proper application in full before deadline
- Provide consent of entry onto property for inspection and construction
- Not alter, move, or modify the project site without written consent of the SRWD
- Be responsible for all associated maintenance of the project (i.e. mowing, controlling livestock, etc)
- Indemnify and save harmless the SRWD from any and all actions, claims, suits, damages, injuries, or other loss arising as a result of the construction, operation, or maintenance of the project.

Watershed District Responsibility:

- The SRWD will provide landowners with preventative resources (i.e. information, contacts)
- Conduct a riparian assessment after receiving completed information form and determine if a willow planting project is required, feasible, and eligible under the program policy
- Plant willow cuttings along a designated waterway or shoreline as per the agreed upon design
- Provide ongoing technical assistance to landowner regarding project and riparian health
- Reserve the right to reasonable access to project site for the purpose of inspection, and of educational tours
