3. Project(s) Description

- Class 1 & 2 wetlands. Maximum annual payment of up to \$75/acre.
- Whitewater Lake – Chronically flooded cultivated acres adjacent to Whitewater Lake annual payment of up to \$25 per acre for landowner to sow to permanent cover. Once permanent cover has established payments would increase to an annual payment of up to \$50 per acre.
- Upland Area. Conservation and restoration of upland areas. Maximum annual payment of up to \$50/acre. Restoration details may include seeding buffer to grass.
- Riparian Area. Conservation and restoration of riparian areas. Maximum annual payment of up to \$50/acre. Restoration details may include livestock exclusion fencing from the project site, off-site/alternative watering systems, and seeding area to grass and/or shrub plantings.
- Water Retention. Construction of water storage areas for flood mitigation, livestock watering and wildlife.
- Livestock Watering Systems. Water Wells, Dugouts, Solar watering systems 50%-100% Funded.
- Field and Yard Shelterbelts 50% - 100% funded. Also eligible to receive up to \$25 an acre for shelterbelt establishment incentive payments.
- Streambank Stabilization 50% - 100% funded.
- Riparian Fencing. 50%-100% Funded.
- Grassed Waterways 50% - 100% funded.
- Forage Seed program landowners, if eligible, can receive 20 to 50 acres of seed at no cost
